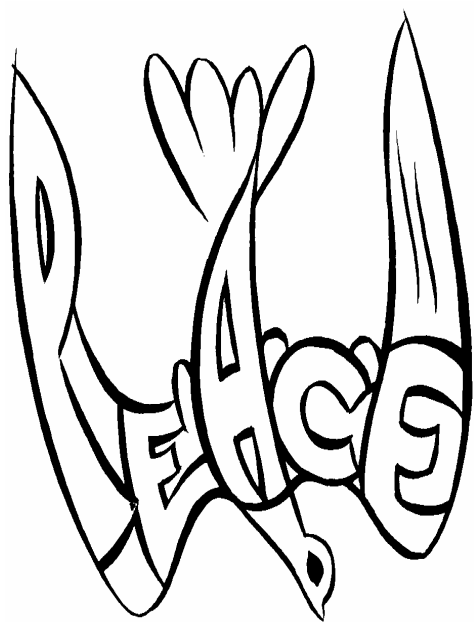

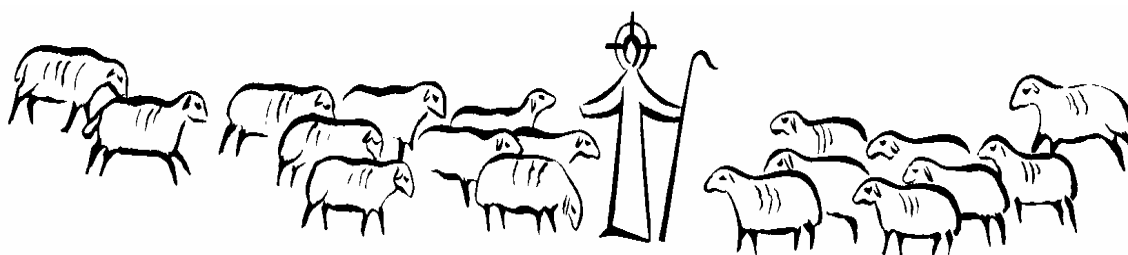
A little something to amuse you!
