Faithfulness to God's will and word, to help us continue to be like these two men.

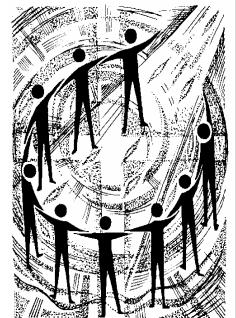
