Sometimes one wonders why a friend, for example, gives us a gift or does what they do. What is their motivation for doing what they do? Or, what is our motivation for keeping the law of the land or obeying God's commandments? If our motivation is not borne out of genuine love of the law of God, we cannot inherit eternal life. So the love of God and neighbour must be in sincere obedience of the law of God and our commitment must be total; "...with all your heart, all your being, all your strength and with all your mind..." (Lk. 10:25ff). In other words, love must be motivated by selflessness.
